




Wall Mount



Freestanding

Options

Options depend on ventilation setup and surface material.

Preferred method for options 1 - 4 Magnetic Installation.

Important General Requirements

Note:

Verify if hood surface works with magnets (for Options 1 - 4)


Power outlet within 6 feet of the desired installation area.

Min 20 inches above Cooking surface required.

Install Cooksy off-center and out of direct line of heat.

For the Wall Mount installation option **3**, the screw attachment method is strongly suggested. 3M possible but not recommended.





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Install Method (A) or (B) Off-Center






Inset or Pullout

Install Method (A) or (B) Off-Center






Over the Range Microwave



Wall Mount

Freestanding

- A Magnetic Installation
- 1 Locate recommended install position (page 06-12).
- 2 Attach Antenna.
- Attached Power Cable to Cooksy.
- 4 Route cable and connect to USB power adapter.

Install Cooksy off-center and out of direct line of heat.










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Note: Clean Area with soapy water, rinse and dry



Assembly

- Insert the tube core onto the center of the bottom base (the end with C angle faces outward).
- 2 Put the pivot ball intro the bracket rod from the round end.
- 3 Cover the tube core with the bracket rod.
- Pass through the bracket rod via the round hole of base cover, then rotate to tighten them.
- 5 Screw the metal nut onto the pivot ball tightly.



Wall Mount

Assemble Wall mount Kit following instructions on page 14 Note: Screws are required



Wall Installation

- 6 Fix the bottom base to the wall via the included screws
- Secure by tightening ring.
- 8 Attach Antenna.
- Attached Power Cable to Cooksy
- Fix the Cooksy on the mount via its female receiver in the back and the pivot ball.
- 11 Screw the plastic wheel to secure Cooksy.
- Route cable and connect to USB power adapter.

IMPORTANT

3M adhesive included to support screw installation.

Do not install without screws.

Warning: Relying on adhesive only is not covered by the manufacture warranty.


G Freestanding

Assemble Freestanding mount Kit following instructions. Position stand left or right of desired cooking surface



Assembly

- Take the arm assembly and insert the large threaded end into the base. Screw the arm assembly in fully until tight.
- 2 Attach the swivel mount to the end of the arm assembly. Screw in the swivel mount until tight.
- Adjust the arm by loosening the large arm nob, rotating the arm, and tightening the arm nob.

Freestanding Installation

- 4 Attach the Cooksy to the swivel mount and tighten the plastic nut.
- 5 Attach Antenna.
- 6 Attached Power Cable.
- 7 Route cable and connect to USB power adapter.
- Position stand left or right of desired cooking surface.




At Cooksy Sensor Startup you will see a Swiping Blue LED Indicator which means Cooksy is ready to be configured

- 1 On the Top left, press the settings icon to open the menu.
- 2 Press the gear icon on the top center to open the App Setting menu.
- 3 Press the Setup Wizard button.

Setup Wizard

Connect your Cooksy Sensor







- 4 Sensor Setup Screen: Press continue
- Choose network, enter Wi-Fi password and connect. White blinking light means its connecting. This will take a few moments
- Once it's connected, it will turn green and Cooksy will show on app. Click the checkbox and then click Done.


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Callibrate

For first time setup, calibrate your Cooksy Cooksy calibrates best with non reflective pan surfaces



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- 1 Place Pan on desired Cooking Surface and apply heat.
- 2 Adjust turret or mount, until thermal circle is centered.
- Use adjust buttons to zoom-in and center the thermo circle.

Quick Start Guide

Ready to Cook

Find recipes in the App, gather the ingredients and start cooking. Follow the chef as they cook instead of following "a recipe".





- 1 Choose recipe on App.
- 2 Watch the 30 seconds preview video.
- Gather ingredients, view the equipment list/prep steps and preview the minute-by-minute cooking Instruction guide.

Pro Tip

Use Cooksy to test your Pans.

The right cookware matters more than the heat source. Tap on the pan on your screen to set heat pins so you can identify your pans with best heat distribution.







- Press the Let's Cook Icon and preheat your cookware as instructed.
- Follow the cooking instructions and re-create the recipe just like the chef intended it, and you end up with the same great food that they did.

- 10) Protect the power cable from being walked on or pinched, submerged or close to liquids, close to heat, particularly at plugs, convenience receptacles, and the point where they exit from the apparatus.
- 11) Only use attachments/accessories specified by the manufacturer
- 12) Unplug this apparatus during lightning storms or when unused for long periods of times.
- 13) Refer all servicing to Cooksy qualified personnel. Servicing is required when the apparatus has been damaged in any way, such as power supply cable or plug is damaged, liquid has been spilled or objects have fallen into the apparatus, the apparatus has been exposed
- to rain or moisture, does not operate normally, or has been dropped.
- 14) The Mains plug should be readily available to disconnect the equipment.
- 15) WARNING: To reduce the risk of fire or electric shock, do not expose this apparatus to rain or moisture.
